Worship Notes

This morning, Bro. Tom will be preaching on a powerful portion of Scripture from Philippians 2 that speaks beautifully of Christ's humility and exaltation. We are reminded in this passage that Christ came from glory, a place of high status and exaltation, and came to this earth, a place that paled in comparison to the beauty and splendor of heaven. To understand truly the depth of Christ's sacrifice, we must consider the height of His glory and stature that He willingly sacrificed and laid aside.

Our opening song, "Glorious Day (Living He Loved Me)," summarizes the life of Christ for us: "Living, He loved me; dying, he saved me; And buried, He carried my sins far away; Rising, He justified freely forever: One day He's coming—O glorious day." The song almost functions like a creed or confession of faith. When we sing it, we're declaring that:

Christ loved us by living a perfect life on our behalf (2 Cor. 5:21; Heb. 4:15).

Christ died to redeem us from our sins (Rom. 5:6, 8).

Christ was buried, and we were buried with Him (Rom. 6:4-6).


Christ was risen for our justification (Rom. 4:25).


Christ will come again (Titus 2:13).

That is the Christ of whom Paul wrote about in Philippians 2. Furthermore, we'll sing of His incarnation ("Here I Am to Worship") and His earthly ministry ("I Will Sing the Wondrous Story") as well as His present ministry to us ("He Touched Me"). And since He is Lord and worthy of all of our praise, as we'll hear in the sermon today, we can declare Him to be "Worthy of Worship" and the One to Whom we will do well to turn our eyes ("Turn Your Eyes upon Jesus"). Truly, if we understand Who Jesus is and what He's done, "The things of earth will grow strangely dim in the light of His glory and grace."
