For each week’s FDG, we will provide the catechism question & answer as well as the associated Scripture references .

<div>1. Read – Read the catechism question, answer and Scripture references. This will be a help and benefit to kids, teens, and adults!</div> <div>2. Memorize – Memorize the catechism question & answer, as well as the Fighter Verse. Recite these together as a family this week.</div> <div>3. Discuss – Utilize the provided discussion questions. Discuss any that apply to this week’s question and answer.</div> <div>4. Worship – Sing the “Hymn of the Week” together as a family. Consider purchasing a hymnal. Recommendations include: <i>The Baptist Hymnal</i> (2008 ed., Lifeway), <i>The Trinity Hymnal: Baptist Edition</i> (Great Commission Publications) and <i>Psalms and Hymns to the Living God</i> (G3 Ministries).</div>

<div>DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR INSTRUCTION</div> <div><div>• Doctrine – What does this truth teach us about: the Bible, God/the Trinity, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, man, salvation, the church, the end times?</div><div>• Law – How does this truth relate to the 10 commandments and God’s law?</div><div>• Gospel – How does this truth relate to the gospel of Jesus Christ?</div></div>
<div>DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR APPLICATION</div> <div><div>• Loving God – How does this truth help us love God?</div><div>• Loving Neighbor – How does this truth help us love our neighbor?</div><div>• Obedience & Repentance – In light of God’s truth, examine your own heart. Is there: sin to confess, promise to claim, attitude to change, command to obey, or example to follow, error to avoid, condition to meet, challenge to face, truth to believe, principle to apply?</div></div>
