Worship Notes

In a day of televangelists who scream and beg for more money and make false promises of the accumulation of wealth, the temptation is for Bible-believing pastors and preachers to avoid the topic of money altogether. However, it's not an option for pastors not to disciple the congregation in the area of stewardship, so today Bro. Tom will begin a 2-part series on giving.

On a personal note, I admit that before I became a Christian I rarely gave to the church. In fact, I felt guilty about my lack of giving and would write down the \$50 here and there that I should have been giving and treat it like a debt. I think it was somewhere between \$500-\$1,000 (keep in mind I was a college student working part-time, so that was months and months of me giving nothing to the Lord). I remember hearing an Adrian Rogers sermon in which he made the statement that he can look at three books and tell much about a person's walk with the Lord: their Bible, their planner, and their checkbook. In other words: **1.** Does this person regularly **study their Bible**? **2.** How does this person **spend their time**? **3.** Does this person **faithfully give**? That sermon has stuck with me, and

The challenge for today is thinking about what worship songs would complement the sermon. As Bro. Tom and I talked, we both (independently, prior to meeting) had the same idea of focusing on Jesus and what He has done for us. Giving to the church is giving to Jesus. Just as the Apostle Paul was told by Jesus, "Why are you persecuting me?" in response to the fact that Paul persecuted the church, so it is that when you give to the church you're really giving to Jesus.

So, we'll sing "**Victory in Jesus**," reminding us that we have victory and riches in glory awaiting us! We'll be reminded to walk "**By Faith**" and "fix our eyes on Him (Jesus), our soul's reward." We'll take encouragement from the message of "**Seek Ye First**": that God will take care of us as we put the kingdom needs first and foremost! "**Rescue the Perishing**" reminds us of the mission and why we give. We help support the church so that we can make disciples of all nations!

We also need to remember that our worth is not in human possession, and as such, we can hold our money with a loose grip, open to the Spirit's leading ("**My Worth is Not in What I Own**"). And we'll end our service by singing of the most valuable aspect of our lives: Jesus! Our joy is not in wealth, which is why we can freely give as God directs us, because Jesus alone can bring us joy ("**Who Can Satisfy My Soul Like You?**")!
