FAMILY DEVOTIONAL GUIDE

DAY 1

- **SCRIPTURE:** Daniel 4:1-3
- **DISCUSSION:** After seeing Hananiah, Mishael & Azariah delivered from the fiery furnace (cf. chap. 3), King Nebuchadnezzar developed a new respect and awe for the Lord God. Do you think Nebuchadnezzar had a better understanding of Yahweh, the God of the Bible? Do you think that Daniel and his friends had a godly influence on his understanding? How might we influence those in authority and their knowledge of biblical truth?
- **SONG:** "Ancient Words" by Lynn DeShazo

DAY 2

- **SCRIPTURE:** Daniel 4:4-25
- **DISCUSSION:** Here we see Nebuchadnezzar being given another dream, and this dream includes a judgment that was soon to come on the king. Discuss the role that judgment plays in the lives of human beings. What might have happened to Nebuchadnezzar had the Lord not executed this punishment mentioned in vv. 24-25?
- **SONG:** "Blessed Be Your Name" by Beth Redman & Matt Redman

DAY 3

- **SCRIPTURE:** Daniel 4:26-27
- **DISCUSSION:** After the judgment pronounced on the king in v. 25, we see that the Lord had a purpose in that judgment (i.e. "till you know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses"). We see here that it is an act of God's grace to teach something of Himself to the king. We also see God's grace here in vv. 26-27 as the Lord confirmed the king's reign (v. 26) and even a hint of "lengthening of your prosperity" (v. 27) if he were to repent of his sins. Spend some time thanking the Lord that there is an assurance of pardon when we come to the Lord in humble repentance, seeking His forgiveness (cf. 1 John 1:9).

BACK TO SUNDAY SCHOOL!

I am very excited about our return to Sunday School next Sunday, September 13! Please pray for your teacher and plan to be present with your family next Sunday. I know there are still valid concerns over the Coronavirus issues but I believe the worst is behind us and that is time to get back to work doing the ministries that God has called us to do. We must trust Him and press on in faith!

Sunday School (SS) is one of the greatest tools Baptists ever came up with to accomplish the Great Commission! SS has two purposes, first, to teach the Bible, and second, to reach the lost. The SS roll is different from the church membership roll. It is a ministry tool. You can be enrolled in SS without being a member of the church. Those who are on our SS rolls represent a list of "prospects," either for church membership or returning to a more active participation in church. Those on the roll who may not be saved are our highest priority evangelistic prospects!

I love SS and have taught a class throughout most of my pastoral ministry. I don't care what you call it, you might prefer life groups, connect groups, Bible study groups, whatever, but the small group focused on teaching God's Word and reaching the lost is what we are all about. That is the Great Commission in action (Matt. 28:16-20). And I do believe Sunday School is still a perfectly acceptable name for it.

I will be teaching the Young Adults and College classes together starting next week and I'm looking forward to digging in to the book of Proverbs. Student books are available on a table in the foyer just outside the worship center.

The **book of Daniel** has given us much food for thought and we have heard the Gospel and been encouraged by the faith of Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah! Lord willing we will press on to Daniel 4 next Sunday and see how God's Truth Triumphs in all circumstances. If you happen to miss one of the sermons, I urge to catch up by listening online.
