FAMILY DEVOTIONAL GUIDE
<p>Our Family Devotional Guide (FDG) is designed to help you walk through biblical truth as a family, utilizing <i>A Catechism for Boys and Girls</i>, as published in <i>Truth &amp; Grace Memory Book</i>. For each week’s FDG, we will provide the <b>catechism question &amp; answer</b> as well as the associated <b>Scripture references</b>.</p> <p>To make the most of this guide, we encourage you to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Read</b> – Read the catechism <b>question, answer</b> and <b>Scripture references</b>. This will be a help and benefit to kids, teens, and adults!</li> <li><b>Memorize</b> – Memorize the <b>catechism question &amp; answer</b>, as well as the <b>Fighter Verse</b>. Recite these together as a family this week.</li> <li><b>Discuss</b> – Utilize the provided discussion questions. Discuss any that apply to this week’s question and answer.</li> <li><b>Worship</b> – Sing the “Hymn of the Week” together as a family. Consider purchasing a hymnal. Recommendations include: <i>The Baptist Hymnal</i> (2008 ed., Lifeway), <i>The Trinity Hymnal: Baptist Edition</i> (Great Commission Publications) and <i>Psalms and Hymns to the Living God</i> (G3 Ministries).</li> </ol> <p><b>This Week’s Catechism Q&amp;A - Question #42</b></p> <p><b>READ &amp; MEMORIZE</b></p> <p><b>Question:</b> What is meant by the atonement?  <b>Answer:</b> Christ satisfying divine justice, by His sufferings and death, in the place of sinners.  <b>Scripture References:</b> Mark 10:45; Acts 13:38-39; Romans 3:24-26; 5:8-9; 2 Corinthians 5:19-21; Galatians 3:13; 1 Peter 3:18  <b>Fighter Verse:</b> Psalm 34:9-11</p> <p><b>DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR INSTRUCTION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Doctrine</b> – What does this truth teach us about: the Bible, God/the Trinity, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, man, salvation, the church, the end times?</li> <li><b>Law</b> – How does this truth relate to the 10 commandments and God’s law?</li> <li><b>Gospel</b> – How does this truth relate to the gospel of Jesus Christ?</li> </ul> <p><b>DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR APPLICATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Loving God</b> – How does this truth help us love God?</li> <li><b>Loving Neighbor</b> – How does this truth help us love our neighbor?</li> <li><b>Obedience &amp; Repentance</b> – In light of God’s truth, examine your own heart. Is there: <b>sin</b> to confess, <b>promise</b> to claim, <b>attitude</b> to change, <b>command</b> to obey, or <b>example</b> to follow, <b>error</b> to avoid, <b>condition</b> to meet, <b>challenge</b> to face, <b>truth</b> to believe, <b>principle</b> to apply?</li> </ul> <p><b>WORSHIP</b>  <b>Hymn of the Week</b> – “And Can It Be” by Charles Wesley</p>

BIBLICAL COUNSELING
<p>Life can be difficult at times. There are seasons when we just wish that we had someone to help us through those difficult times. Here at Tabernacle, we believe that God’s Word has an answer for all of life’s problems. II Peter 1:3 states, <i>“His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence”</i>. If you find yourself in one of these seasons, please see Pastor Jon or go to our website to sign up for an appointment. You will also find paperwork that helps the counselor get to know you a bit before you arrive. The paperwork can be downloaded, completed, then emailed, or it can be printed at your convenience, completed, and brought to the church office.</p> <p>Problems with life are not a new thing. We all have them; you are not alone. Let Tabernacle come alongside you with the Bible to ease the pain and bring hope and help from God’s perspective.</p>
PRAYER ROOM MESSAGE
<p><b>When we pray “Our Father,” what are we saying?</b> “Our” reflects unselfishness, and “Father” expresses family devotion. The fact that God is our Father means that only believers in Christ are in His family. Unbelievers have another father spiritually. God is the Father in heaven to those who trust in Him. In all of Jesus’ prayers except one, He used the word “Father” or “Abba” which is like saying “daddy” today. This emphasizes the personal and intimate relationship God has with His children. What are the implications of this as we approach “Our Father” in prayer?
