FAMILY DEVOTIONAL GUIDE
Our Family Devotional Guide (FDG) is designed to help you walk through biblical truth as a family, utilizing <i>A Catechism for Boys and Girls</i>, as published in <i>Truth & Grace Memory Book</i>. For each week’s FDG, we will provide the catechism question & answer as well as the associated Scripture references. To make the most of this guide, we encourage you to: Read – Read the catechism question, answer and Scripture references. This will be a help and benefit to kids, teens, and adults! Memorize – Memorize the catechism question & answer, as well as the Fighter Verse. Recite these together as a family this week. Discuss – Utilize the provided discussion questions. Discuss any that apply to this week’s question and answer. Worship – Sing the “Hymn of the Week” together as a family. Consider purchasing a hymnal. Recommendations include: <i>The Baptist Hymnal</i> (2008 ed., Lifeway), <i>The Trinity Hymnal: Baptist Edition</i> (Great Commission Publications) and <i>Psalms and Hymns to the Living God</i> (G3 Ministries).
This Week’s Catechism Q&A - Question #60
READ & MEMORIZE Question: Why is Christ a king? Answer: Because He rules over us and defends us. Scripture References: Psalm 2:6-9; Matthew 28:18-20; Ephesians 1:19-23; Colossians 1:13, 18; Revelation 15:3-4 Fighter Verse: Psalm 84:10-12
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR INSTRUCTION Doctrine – What does this truth teach us about: the Bible, God/the Trinity, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, man, salvation, the church, the end times? Law – How does this truth relate to the 10 commandments and God’s law? Gospel – How does this truth relate to the gospel of Jesus Christ?
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR APPLICATION Loving God – How does this truth help us love God? Loving Neighbor – How does this truth help us love our neighbor? Obedience & Repentance – In light of God’s truth, examine your own heart. Is there: sin to confess, promise to claim, attitude to change, command to obey, or example to follow, error to avoid, condition to meet, challenge to face, truth to believe, principle to apply?

BIBLICAL COUNSELING

PRAYER ROOM MESSAGE Forgiving Others is the Ultimate Test - This principle is simple yet very sobering. If we have forgiven, then we will be forgiven; if we have not forgiven, we will not be forgiven. Forgiveness is the mark of a truly regenerate heart. Jesus is the pattern of forgiveness. Any offense towards us can never match what Christ endured. The sin of an unforgiving heart and bitter spirit forfeits blessing and invites chastening. Our sin is an ongoing problem, but God’s provision is continual forgiveness. The prerequisite is that we forgive others. An unforgiving Christian is a proud, selfish person who has forgotten that his sins were washed away! “If you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions.” Matthew 6:15
